MCIR Background

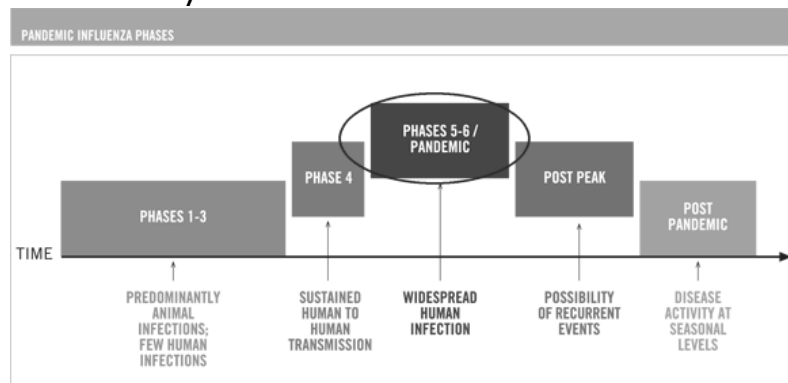
- Used by providers since 1998 for the reporting of childhood immunizations
- Legislation (Public Act 91 of 2006) allowed MCIR to:
 - Become a lifetime immunization registry
 - Store other population-based health indicators:
 - Lead, Newborn metabolic, & hearing screening
 - All Hazards Event tracking

MCIR All Hazard Function

- In an All Hazard situation, MCIR will track administration of:
 - Vaccines
 - Antivirals
- This function will be activated if the Pandemic Influenza Alert Level reaches World Health Organization (WHO) Phase 4

WHO Phases of Pandemic Alert

- Currently at Phase 6 due to Novel H₁N₁



Registering with MCIR

- Each Provider Site location administering vaccine or dispensing antivirals from the national stockpile must register to use MCIR
- Decide who at your Provider Site will be the MCIR Site Administrator
 - Responsible for adding and maintaining a list of your agency's MCIR users.
 - MCIR Site Administrator Training is available as a separate training video at this website.

MCIR Registration Process

- MCIR Site Administrator must complete a Provider User/Usage Agreement
 - Must be signed by the licensing physician
 - Send it to the appropriate Regional MCIR Office
- E-mail will be sent to the Site Administrator
 - Contains MCIR PIN number and registration instructions
- Site Administrator must
 - Complete their own registration
 - Create PIN numbers for other MCIR Users at their site
