Subject: MCIR Modernization Update: New Go-Live Date and Training Ahead

We are pleased to share important updates as we move closer to the launch of the modernized Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR).

New Go-Live Date

A single, statewide system will remain in place throughout the transition, with an additional feature release planned after launch:

- **June 15, 2026:** The new system, STC|ONE, will launch with core functionality and be available for use.
- **July 2026:** Michigan-specific customizations and reporting will be available.

This approach supports a stable launch while allowing time for additional features to be introduced.

Training Now Available

Medical providers gained access to the Learning Management System (LMS) on April 6. Login Credentials were sent to the email address associated with users [MiLogin](#) account. Training is role-based and designed to focus on the tasks you perform every day--no unnecessary content or one-size-fits-all modules.

Important: Please work with your IT department to allow (or whitelist) noreply@tovutimail.com to ensure you receive LMS communications.

What You Can Do Now

Take these steps to ensure you receive important updates and can access training:

- Verify your [MiLogin](#) information:

- Confirm your email address is corrected (used for LMS access).
 - Ensure your phone number is current for Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA).

Did You Know?

The transition to STC|ONE will continue to support secure data exchange through the Immunization (IZ Gateway), a CDC-supported national system.

Through the IZ Gateway, MCIR shares immunization data with multiple states and federal partners, including Veterans Affairs (VA) and refugee health programs. This helps providers access more complete vaccination histories, reduce duplicate vaccinations, and support continuity of care across state lines.

More updates will be shared in the coming weeks. Thank you for your continued partnership and support as we modernize MCIR.
