As we move through fall, we’re excited to share the latest progress on MCIR Modernization and what’s ahead as we prepare for statewide rollout.

📌 **Data Migration Update**

STChealth, the vendor supporting Michigan’s immunization system, has transitioned from Tharseo to Iatric Systems for data migration services. Our vendor has assured us that this transition supports a smoother and more scalable migration process, and our go live timing remains on track.

🔧 **Training Milestones**

Training efforts continue to advance, with recent milestones and new opportunities designed to help partners prepare for the transition.

- **State Administrator Training** was successfully completed onsite with STC in mid-October.
- **Train-the-Trainer sessions** concluded October 23, equipping key staff to support broader rollout.
- **Self-service training** modules are now available through the Learning Management System.
- **Local Health Department (LHD) training** is scheduled for December, with access instructions coming soon.
