**Subject:** MCIR Modernization: Updates on transitioning to a new IIS, STC|One.

We are pleased to share the latest developments:

- **STChealth Site Visit:** In April, representatives from STChealth visited Michigan to meet with MCIR team members and stakeholders. The visit fostered valuable opportunities for collaboration, system planning, and feedback. STChealth is expected to return in mid-May for continued discussions and next-phase planning.
- **Education & Training Planning:** Work is underway to develop a comprehensive education and training plan to support users throughout the transition. These efforts aim to ensure all users are well-prepared for the new system.
- **Data Mapping between the current MCIR and STC|ONE:** Our technical team is actively reviewing the current MCIR system ensuring accurate data migration to the new STC|ONE immunization information system. Strategic efforts continue assuring the quality and integrity of immunization data.
- **Electronic Data Exchange (HL7):** A dedicated team is analyzing the electronic data exchange to continue seamless data flow, which supports real-time access of data and ensures data integrity for accuracy and completeness through implementation. Additional communication on required updates will be shared soon.

We remain on track to implement the new system in 2026. Key milestones are being met, and collaboration across teams continues to support a smooth and successful transition.
