School and Childcare Reporting

STChealth and MDHHS have finalized requirements to streamline immunization reporting for schools and childcare providers.

Legacy Data Mapping and Validation

The team is actively verifying the mapping of legacy MCIR data into STC|ONE. This critical, iterative process involves loading and reviewing data in the STC Test environment to ensure fields and values transfer accurately. The goal is to confirm data integrity ahead of the system cutover in 2026.

Training and Education

An internal workgroup is defining the minimum training requirements for all STC|ONE users.
