Subject: MCIR MOD Transition: Guidance on Preparing for the Upcoming MCIR/SIRS Transition

Dear School and Childcare Partners,

The Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) is transitioning to a new system, STC|ONE, as part of MCIR Modernization.

On Monday, June 15, 2026, the new MCIR system (STC|ONE) will go live. To prepare for this transition, access to legacy MCIR—including the School Immunization Reporting System (SIRS)—will end at the close of business (COB) on June 10, 2026.

All work in the legacy system must be completed by this deadline, as the system will no longer be available after that time.

Core MCIR functionality will be available in STC|ONE on Monday, June 15, 2026. School and childcare reporting (SIRS) functionality will be available at a later date and will be communicated directly to all currently registered users in MCIR.

All current and active MCIR SIRS Users are requested to complete the following steps before the initial transition to STC|ONE.

Required Actions Before June 10, 2026

All active MCIR SIRS users should complete the following:

1. Update MiLogin for Business account information

- To gain access to mandatory online training in the STC|ONE Learning Management System (LMS) once available:
 - Verify primary email and phone number are current. (Use a cell phone number to support multi-factor authentication.)
 - Ask your IT department to allow emails from noreply@tovutimail.com to receive LMS credentials. This is also called whitelisting, which means the emails will not be blocked or sent to spam.

2. Verify contact information in MCIR is current

- Update user contact details
- Update school/childcare contact information, including:
 - Immunization reporting staff
 - Superintendent
 - Principal
 - Childcare Director

3. Preserve existing reports

- Do not remove children/students from:
 - October 2025 report
 - February 2026 report

4. Prepare upcoming reporting

- Add:
 - Schools
 - Incoming kindergarteners
 - Incoming 7th graders
 - New students (as of January 1, 2026)
 - Mark for November 2026 reporting
 - Childcares
 - Add all newly enrolled children (as of January 1, 2026)
 - Mark for October 2026 reporting

5. Run and send notifications

- Run the Future Vaccine Need Report to identify children within the facility due for vaccines in the next 12 months.
- Mail letters to parents as soon as possible to promote on time immunization compliance.

6. Build and save reports before system shutdown

- Prepare the Oct/Nov 2026 reporting period
- Print reports by June 1, 2026:
 - Alpha List of Students
 - Letters to Parents
 - Incompletes (Detailed)
 - Provisionals (Detailed)
 - Waivers (Detailed)
 - Future Vaccine Need

During the Transition (While SIRS is Unavailable)

Schools and childcares will need to:

7. Manually verify immunization status

- For new students/children, families must contact their healthcare providers or LHDs to obtain a child's immunization status.

8. Complete required training

- Users must complete STC|ONE LMS training to regain reporting access.

9. Rebuild reports in STC|ONE

- Use the printed Alpha List
- Add any new students not included
