

# What is MCIR Modernization?

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MCIR Modernization is a statewide effort to move the Michigan Care Improvement Registry (MCIR) to a cloud-based, secure, and scalable system called STC|ONE. This transition supports better data sharing, faster system performance, and improved access to immunization records.

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## What This Means for Tribal Health Partners

As we move away from Legacy MCIR and toward STC|ONE, our goal is to ensure Tribal Health programs experience:

- Continued access to immunization records during the transition.
- Support for data entry and retrieval workflows, including HL7 message processing.
- Ongoing data security protection.
- Continuous interoperability with other systems you may use, (e.g. EHRs, RPMs, IHS).
- Onboarding and training support for Tribal providers.

We are working closely with STChealth to **minimize disruption** for Tribal health teams and ensure historical data and account access are preserved across systems.

## Accomplishments to Date

- Test environment is loaded with real-world organization and facility records.
- LexisNexis cleansing completed to ensure accurate patient information.

## In Progress

- Input gathering through regional planning calls and onboarding surveys.
- MILogin Integration to enable secure access and Multi-Factor Authentication.
- Application Programming Interface (API) upgrades in progress to streamline Electronic Health Record (EHR) connections and data submissions.

## Steps for Tribal Partners to Prepare

1. Review communication for upcoming onboarding instructions.
2. Identify staff who need access and training.
3. Review organization or site contact information was sent to MCIR correctly.
